What is COSP?

The Child Online Safeguarding Policy or COSP is a policy that aims to protect Filipino youths accessing the Free Internet for All program from all harms of the internet.

COSP can protect you from all harms of the internet namely but not limited to:

- ✓ Online Gambling
- ✓ Child Pornography
- ✓ Cyberbullying
- ✓ Privacy Violation
- ✓ Online Harrassment and Abuse
